Pascal Ungerer is an Irish artist originally from West Cork. He worked as a photographer before becoming a full-time artist.

He is interested in looking at the in-between spaces that lie at the outskirts of towns; where industrial buildings meet the nature of the countryside.

He is drawn to unusual structures in the landscape, as well as places that have hidden histories.

Speculative means something that is based on a guess rather than factual information. An **Artefact** is an object that has been made by a person. It is usually referred to as something that is of historical interest.
